

## **CLASS LOCATIONS**

All Pre-kindergarten through grade 3 classes are held at the Lake Mills Elementary School. All grade 4 - 8 classes are held at Lake Mills Middle School. Exceptions: gymnastic (HS lower gym), bowling (Hering's Fish Bowl), soccer (HS field), golf (LM Golf Course) and middle school weight training (HS weight room). Transportation will be provided between school and the above locations.

## PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM

We would like to invite you to participate in an enrichment summer school program for any child who will be eligible to attend public school (5 years old by September 1) kindergarten in the fall of 2021. As educators, we look upon this program as a positive means to assist young children making the transition to the kindergarten setting.

## **ONLINE COURSE SELECTION**

If your student is currently enrolled in the LMASD, you will use your <u>parent</u> Family Access login and password to sign up for courses. Using a student login and password will not grant access to schedule summer school courses.

## PRE-REGISTRATION

If your student is not currently enrolled in the LMASD, you will need to pre-register. The pre-registration forms are located on our website at <a href="http://www.lakemills.k12.wi.us/families/SS-Registration-Materials.cfm">http://www.lakemills.k12.wi.us/families/SS-Registration-Materials.cfm</a> The completed paperwork is due by <a href="March 26">March 26</a>, to the District Office. This is a firm due date; late paperwork may result in receiving your login and password late. Parents will receive an email containing login and password information one to two days prior to the opening of online course selection.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

Transportation of students to and from school will be a parent responsibility, including swim lessons.

## STUDENT SCHEDULES

Student course schedules will be sent home the last week of school and available online in family access.

## **COURSE DROP/ADD & REFUND POLICY**

Course changes will only be allowed during the first 2 days of each session; course fees will only be refunded within the 2 day time frame.

## **TUITION for NON-DISTRICT STUDENTS**

Any student seeking entrance into the Lake Mills Area School District summer school program must reside within the established boundaries of the district. The child's parent or legal guardian must reside within the Lake Mills Area School District boundaries. Non-resident students will be charged tuition in accordance with state tuition laws (121.77). Non-resident students who have applied to the Board of Education by April 2021 for the Public School Open Enrollment Program, and have been approved to enroll for the 2021-22 school year, may have tuition waived for summer school.

## SWIM LESSONS

Swim lessons will be held July 6 - July 21 at Sandy Beach; parents must provide transportation. Families need to sign up for swimming lessons during online course selection. Please remember one swim session per child. Some testing will be done on the first day of swim lessons to further enable our instructors to properly place the student.

Students must have passed Level 3 to take this class.

## **Level V: Sharks ~ Stroke Refinement**

Students must have passed Level 4 to take this class.


