LEN BROSIG SCHOLARSHIP

Len was a long time Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WIDNR) employee stationed in Jefferson County and was one of the first individuals to offer a Hunter Education/Safety course to Fort Atkinson's youth in the 1960's. In recognition of Len's dedication in preserving and improving our environment, the Fort Atkinson Wisconservation Club awards \$2,500.00, to a lone recipient, to be used to help defray educational expenses.

This scholarship is open to all seniors, in good standing, enrolled at Whitewater, Cambridge, Jefferson, Lake Mills, Milton, Edgerton, Lakeside Lutheran, or Fort Atkinson High Schools, and/or, legal dependents of a club member in good standing that are enrolled at an area school.

The money shall be given to the scholarship recipient after he or she has successfully completed one (1) semester of college course work and has provided a copy of their semester transcript(s) to an active board member for verification of completion and archive.

A panel of Fort Atkinson Wisconservation Club members shall choose the successful recipient.

Hopefully, although not required, the recipient will be a graduate of our hunter education program. Also, we hope, this individual will have demonstrated an active interest in some of the following areas: hunting, fishing, environmental issues, ecology, or conservation.

Deadline for scholarship applications is the <u>last Friday of January each year</u>, with the successful recipient being notified by a board member the end of February. Fort Atkinson High School applicants shall turn their application into the school; all other applications shall be submitted via U.S. Mail at the address below. The successful recipient, and his or her parent(s) or guardian, shall be the guests of the Fort Atkinson Wisconservation Club at their annual awards banquet in March. At this time the recipient will be recognized by the members in attendance and will receive a voucher good for \$2,500.00 that is redeemable in cash money after the successful completion of one (1) semester of college course work.
